- Module 10:** Evaluation of Workshop
- Module 11:** Change-Breakers
- Module 12:** Action Plan to Combat Hate

Key expert leaders from partnering human rights and hate crime agencies conduct the training in small groups. These experts are selected to maximize the participants' ability to impact his/her college campus as an educator on hate crime prevention. Throughout the next year, participants can commit to be a part of the Stop The Hate consortium of educators to combat hate on campus and implement an action plan consisting of a minimum of six hate crime prevention efforts that might include workshops, seminars, rallies, writing articles, developing campus response teams, etc.
